<i>Details</i>	<p>Come and enjoy a summers evening concert by Bristol Chamber Choir. This will include madrigals by two of the greatest Elizabethan madrigal composers, Thomas Weelkes and John Wilbye.</p> <p>The BCC was founded in 1837 as the Bristol Madrigal Society, changing its name to BCC a hundred and fifty years later, and at its first meeting a Wilbye madrigal was sung. One of its founding members at that first meeting was Robert Pearsall, two of whose eight-part madrigals will also be part of this concert.</p> <p>The programme will also include Milton's 'Ode on Time' set to music by Sir Charles Villiers Stanford, and Keats's 'La Belle Dame sans Merci' set to music by Sir Hubert Parry. The Parry connection makes the visit of the choir to Highnam especially significant.</p>
